The stock of renewable and non-renewable natural resources that combine to yield a flow of benefits to people.

Social capital

The networks together with shared norms, values and understanding that facilitate cooperation within and among groups.



Human capital

The knowledge, skills, competencies and attributes embodied in individuals that contribute to improved performance and well-being.

Produced capital

The human-made goods as well as all financial assets that are used to produce goods and services consumed by society.

By participating in the training program, you will:

- Learn how to enhance your **business strategy**, **corporate social responsibility and sustainability** uptake based on an improved understanding of the risks and opportunities in your value chain


