In a nutshell

NextEnergy Group – in collaboration with Etifor – is launching a robust and holistic strategy to assess, manage, and disclose its nature-related risks and opportunities related to renewable energy investment, development, and asset management.

NextEnergy Group's nature strategy builds on best practices and frameworks – including the Taskforce for Nature-related Financial Disclosures (TNFD) and Science Based Targets for Nature (SBTN) – to align itself with the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework and anticipate the growing demand for nature disclosures and due diligence.

The strategy aims to embed the value of natural capital and ecosystem services into The Group's business model and decision-making, effectively and transparently manage physical and transition risks, align with global nature, climate, and biodiversity targets, and demonstrate the ambition and resilience of their business model to their stakeholders.

The Nature Strategy follows the recommendations of the ACT-D framework endorsed by the Capitals Coalition to Assess, Commit, Transform, and Disclose on nature topics.

The Strategy consolidates and builds upon the lessons NextEnergy Group has learned from nearly 20 years of active environmental engagement while looking ahead to meet ambitious global targets. It signifies a shift toward a more coherent and centralised framework that determines its engagement with nature-related issues while recognising the nuances of each of its assets. Most importantly, the Nature Strategy reflects the scale and ambition of the Group; it establishes a science-based and evidence-led thread uniting Starlight, NextEnergy Capital and WiseEnergy to ensure a consistent and standardised approach to meet our nature commitments.

NextEnergy Group commits to contributing its part to realising the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (KM-GBF) targets, the Global Goal for Nature, and a nature positive economy by 2030 by supporting the transition toward an economy that operates within safe planetary boundaries. .
