



Youth Consultation on NBSAP Implementation

In a nutshell

The Nigerian Youth Biodiversity Network organised a national youth consultation series on the NBSAP review and implementation processes. The national youth consultation process includes a national youth survey on the Post 2020 GBF, NBSAP youth influencers mobilisation of youth priorities, virtual capacity building training and a wrap up physical workshop that led to the production of a draft national youth policy on NBSAP implementation, a Youth Engagement Strategy, design of a monitoring framework to track the implementation progress of the NBSAP, and the creation of a Post 2020 GBF illustration chart.

Our case study focuses on resource mobilisations and roles of small and medium enterprises in financing the implementation of the NBSAP. In the 12-month youth consultation process, we were able to identify key youth priorities and national interests in the uptake of Targets 15 and 19 of the Post 2020 GBF.
